Offer the opportunity to travel with and support the trainers whilst training.

Completion of yellow green and violet training opportunities, including gaining an in depth knowledge of the organisation

Maintain your handbook and identify your own training needs.

Excellent awareness of the issues surrounding domestic violence.

Excellent understanding of confidentiality and a willingness to work within Staffordshire Women's Aid policies procedures, guidelines aims and objectives.

Clear understanding of appropriate boundaries and a willingness to work within them.

Awareness of the role limitations and willingness to work as a team.

Non-judgmental, accepting and professional approach to potentially vulnerable people.

Good oral communication skills and confidence to deal with a diversity of people, some of who may be in distressing situations.

Reliability honesty and adaptability.
